Under Tree Schools - education of girls in South Sudan

Our charity of the month runs a school. Before 2005 only boys went to school in South Sudan. Girls helped in the home, got married at 14 and had their first child at 15. The UTS school shows that there is another way. Every year since it opened in 2009 350 girls age 6-15 have attended the school. A dozen or so stay the course to reach the top year. UTS then pays their fees to go to secondary school and the first group of those finish secondary school this December. They can then go on to careers - in education, medicine etc - all the skills so needed in their new country.

St Mary's has been a keen supporter of the school from the start. We helped build it and now we help fund its running costs. UTS has been a major beneficiary of the Barnes Charity Ball each year; there are Saturday coffee shops during the year; our young people have made it their main charity, fundraising in Advent and at the Barnes Fair; and some of us give regularly to UTS by standing order.

Come to the UTS stall opposite Hillersdon Avenue at Barnes Fair on Saturday, and get some of the good things on sale, in support of girls who are desperate for education.

Summer BBQ Brunch. Sun 9th July immediately after the 10am service. This a special St Mary's Church Family event for everyone and there will be the usual delicious burgers and hot dogs and in addition some activities organised by the young people suitable for all ages. Meal tickets available on Sundays after the services at £2.50 which will entitle you to one meal item. Do join us if you can.
