Bishop's Certificate in Discipleship: Every year our Diocese runs a year-long course to help people to learn more about the Christian faith in a thorough and systematic way. It is called The Bishop's Certificate in Discipleship. There are six modules:

- Exploring our identity and the Church

- Following Jesus through the New Testament
- Understanding the teaching of the Church

- Responding to the Holy Spirit in prayer and worship.
