UNDER TREE SCHOOLS - giving girls a choice to have a career in South Sudan

Wonderfully the school survives the insecurity of the civil war and the associated economic collapse and huge inflation. Our payments to the school buy much less than a few years ago. If you could afford a small regular donation to help to staff and feed the school, the charity website www.undertreeschools.com explains how to do it. When will the civil war end, so security can return and the economy grow?

A settlement between the main contending factions has just been brokered by neighbouring countries. A cease fire was agreed. However as with previous agreements the fighting has not stopped. Negotiations continue. It seems that a solution is being proposed under which all the parties would get seats in the Government. Whether all sides will stop aiming to enrich themselves and instead agree to work selflessly in the interest of the country we will need to wait and see. Joseph has been trying to exert his influence to get the warring parties to see the bigger picture.

Invitation to farewell service: All are invited to the farewell service for Rev'd Richard Sewell, Team Rector of Barnes, on Sunday 16th September at 6pm at St Mary's Church. Richard is leaving to take on the role of Dean of St George's College, Jerusalem, from 1st October. The College belongs to the Diocese of Jerusalem and is a community of education, hospitality, pilgrimage and reconciliation. The post also involves being installed as a residentiary canon of St George's Cathedral. The Bishop of Kingston will preach at the service on 16th September and he will also commission Richard in his new role on behalf of the Church of England. The service will be followed by a reception in Kitson Hall and all are welcome.

Rev'd Adam Rylett: We are delighted to announce that the Bishop of Southwark together with the Diocesan Board of Patronage have appointed the Revd Adam Rylett to the post of Vicar of St Paul's Kingston Hill, subject to the usual legal formalities.
