UNDER TREE SCHOOLS girls school in South Sudan, our charity of the month

Our school continues to thrive. We at St Mary's consider it to be "our "school because we have been involved with it from the start in 2005, helping to set up the charity, helping to fund the construction, and since 2009 when it opened, helping to fund the running costs. Joseph Ayok and his family are friends of St Mary's and we see them when Joseph is in England. Joseph was our curate when civil war ended in 2005 and he was able to start to implement his vision for educating girls, who until then had not been eligible to go to school.

Ten years after the school opened we have exciting practical evidence of its achieving its aims. The first girls from our primary school have now graduated from local secondary schools and this year are in training as teachers, nurses or seamstresses.
