SOUTH WEST LONDON WELCARE WORKING IN BARNES

St. Mary's has long supported the charity, Welcare, which provides practical and emotional help to strengthen families who are experiencing difficulties. They work with children up to 13 years old. Debbie Eldridge, Welcare's Senior Family Support Worker is liaising with staff at Castelnau Community Centre(CCP) and engaging with Barnes families to give them the support they need. My Space is a new initiative and a proven recovery programme for parents and children who have experienced domestic abuse, based at CCP and a local primary school. Welcare needs volunteers to assist with practical help for families and/or mentoring a child who needs help. Full training and support will be given.
